**Jack DuVall** is President of the International Center on Nonviolent Conflict, Washington D.C. He is an acclaimed author, speaker and television producer with a specialty in nonviolent conflict. He was the Executive Producer of the two-part Emmy-nominated PBS-TV series, "*A Force More Powerful: A Century of Nonviolent Conflict*," and co-author of the companion book of the same name (Palgrave/St. Martin's Press 2001).

Mr. DuVall was also Vice President for Program Resources of WETA, Washington, D.C. and previously was Director of Corporate Relations of the University of Chicago; a political speechwriter; and a counterintelligence officer in the U.S. Air Force. He has lectured at several universities in the United States. His media appearances have included MSNBC's Nachman Show, ABC News Channel 8 (Washington, DC), ABC TV (Australia), CBC (television and radio), CBS Radio, CKNW (Vancouver), National Public Radio, News Channel 12 (Long Island) and RadioNation. He has been cited in such publications as the New York Times, the Los Angeles Times, the Nation, the Philadelphia Inquirer, the Vancouver Sun, and U.S. News and World Report.
