- Assist in designing and disseminating bimonthly newsletter containing news items and ICNC blog posts (mindsofthemovement.org)

- Regularly track and report on newsletter and site metrics for monthly ICNC analytics reports
- Assist in developing and implementing social media and external communications strategy to promote the NVCNews.org website, including drafting copy for NVCNews social media channels (Twitter and Facebook)
